Gearing up for plane comfort

Planecomfort is made for the airplane, but its blanket — and the fact that folks don't seem to be using pillows and blankets much on planes these days, and who wants to be seen blowing up an inflatable pillow? — makes it far better suited for car trips and other uses. Made from microfleece, the unit all bundled together measures about 16 inches wide by 10 inches high. But it comes with a strap to count as its own carry on and has a pouch in which to put magazines, with the pouch serving as a pillowcase when empty. This way, if you are one of the rare people still fighting over the few blankets and pillows they have floating around on the planes these days, you never have to worry that the airline hasn't washed them (as if!).
